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

IMPORTANT PAYMENT INFORMATION

Please apply for EIP at www.ecetp.pdp.albany.edu. We do not want EIP applications or a copy of your income taxes. We only need proof of EIP eligibility (for example, approval letter, denial letter). If you are 100% eligible for EIP funding, you do not have to pay a co-pay.

FEN Scholarship Eligibility: If you are not eligible for 100% EIP funding, you are eligible for a Family Enrichment Network Scholarship for child care provider training as long as we have verification that you are not EIP eligible. You must fill out an EIP application (to document that you are not eligible for EIP) or show us income proof *and* a FEN scholarship application. You will receive a voucher for each class you are approved for. You must turn in the voucher as payment for each training. There is also a \$10.00 co -pay you must make for each training you attend. You will not be enrolled in training until the \$10.00 is paid. You will not receive a training certificate until the \$10.00 is paid.

You are also eligible for a FEN Scholarship if you are eligible for EIP, *<u>if</u> EIP funds are not available*. You will need a letter from EIP stating that you have been denied for funding.

If you are EIP eligible and do not apply for EIP, you are not eligible for the FEN scholarship and must pay the full cost of the class listed.

Classes not eligible for EIP are listed. These classes are also not FEN scholarship eligible. These include, but are not limited to, CPR/First Aid classes and the Health and Safety Training.

Please call any CCR&R Specialist with questions about how EIP and payment works.


