<u>Johnson City:</u> If you are coming to a training in the evening or the weekend, please use the visitor parking lot on the right side of the building in Johnson City, or park on the street. Please do not park in the fenced-in bus and employee parking lot.

<u>Binghamton:</u> You can park on the same side of the street as our building or in the church parking lot on the corner of Fayette St. and Court St. (We no longer rent parking in the lot across the street, so parking there is at your own risk.)

Owego: The entrance to the building is on the left side and parking is available in that area.

Norwich: You can park in the public parking lot (off Main St, turn into Theatre Lane to parking lot, or off Broad Street turn into the ally way next to the movie theater to access the parking lot).
