What is a Child Care Resource and Referral Agency?

The Child Care Resource & Referral (CCR&R) is an integral part of Family Enrichment Network. We are a community coordinating and planning agency for local child care services and offer a variety of supports for early childhood professionals, parents, and businesses.

For Parents:

Qualified counselors:

- Explain child care choices
- Help families find child care
- Offer suggestions about parenting issues
- Present seminars and workshops for parents on a variety of child development topics/life issues
- Facilitate interactive workshops for parents and children

For Child Care Providers:

Providers in the database receive:

- Referrals to their child care programs
- Assistance with the registration process
- Workshops and training opportunities to satisfy the NYSOCFS requirements
- Professional development opportunities
- Information regarding best practices in child care
- Access to CCR&R's Training Calendar and Network News newsletter

For Employers:

Employers are quickly learning that businesses can benefit when attention is paid to employees' child care/parenting needs. Employer assistance in child care is one of the fastest growing employee benefits. Among its many services to employer groups, a CCR&R agency:

- Maintains data which reflects the current supply and demand trends in child care and develops child care services specific to the needs of the employer's workforce
- Conducts seminars for employees on a variety of topics including balancing work and family, child care issues, and parenting concerns





Questions To Ask When Inquiring About A Summer Program

- What will you be expected to provide? Snacks/meals ? Bug repellant? Sun screen? Floaties and a towel?
- Is transportation provided?
- What are the times and additional costs of before and after camp care?
- Do field trips and special event opportunities require additional fees?
- Do they have emergency procedures in place? What are they?
- What is the "drop-in" policy for parents?
- How can parents get involved?

Additional Reminders:

- Where swimming is offered, make sure to:
 - Review your child's skill level with the instructor.
 - Ask to see the instructor's certification.
- Ask the camp to describe typical activities planned for your child's age group.
