Family Enrichment Network Distributes Calming Centers

Family Enrichment Network CCR&R was awarded a grant by the Broome County United Way through the *United We Stand Fund*, which was created to address the critical needs of those impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

This past year, family and group family child care providers in Broome County noticed the social-emotional impact of the pandemic on the children in their program. Caregivers recognized how these challenges affect the children's mental health. CCR&R designed Calming Centers to help caregivers support and protect children's emotional well-being. Calming centers will help the children express their difficult feelings, such as anger, sadness, and fear in appropriate ways.

The Calming Centers consist of resources on social-emotional development so caregivers can help the children recognize, label, and manage their emotions. Supplies include posters identifying feelings, a variety of children's books on different feelings and emotions, mirror to identify their own emotions, bubble timer, white noise machine, feeling dolls and balls, fidget toys, sensory cushion, and a cuddle ball. The Infant Toddler Mental Health Consultant and Early Childhood Mental Health Consultant services are available to assist programs with improving the social-emotional environment as well.
